And a brand that was started by a true petrolhead. MG stands for "Morris Garages," a dealer of Morris cars which began producing it's own customized versions, specializing in two-seat open sports cars. This example was even owned by a famous Belgian.

The styling of the car was undeniably elegant. Its aerodynamic design and two-seat open-body continue to elate the senses. The vehicle sat on widely spaced side rails, providing excellent handling and a low center of gravity. It is a true roadster, with a soft top and side curtains to keep the weather out.

The bulletproof 1489 cc engine fitted with twin H4 type SU Carburetors produced 68 hp (51 kW) at first, but was soon upgraded to 72 hp (54 kW). Lockheed hydraulic drum brakes were used on all wheels.

The car starts readily, sound fantastic, and pulls strongly in all gears, and the car needs nothing to be enjoyed immediately. The car is very honest and mechanically sound and it handles great Our beautiful example was exported from the United states in 1997 into Holland. It immediately received a full restoration giving her the cream exterior with red leather interior. It stayed in Holland until 2010 when it was sold through Wim Prins classics to a very Famous Belgian car enthusiast. He



kept her at his tuscan wine vineyard until last year. We were able to acquire her from our famous Belgian in an exchange with a Renault alpine A110 that we prepped for him to do rally's.

An MGA is a beautiful design that is fun to drive and easy to maintain. This example has been well tended to by a meticulous owner, offers no excuses, and will be providing great driving fun for many years to come. Are you the one to enjoy it?
