

BMW Z8 ROADSTER E52



Rare "Topazblau" 2000 BMW Z8 roadster with cream full leather interior. Powered by the M5 derivate, the 4.9 liter V8 - 32 valve engine producing 400 hp. Attached to a 6 speed manual gearbox. Giving this all aluminum chassis and body an acceleration from standstill to 100 km/h in 4.7 seconds and a limited topspeed of 250 km/h. Equipped with a beautiful set of 18 inch alloys. The E52 was a limited edition production model, with an expensive MIG welded aluminum space frame and all were hand finished in Munchen. It was an outstanding styling exercise to evoke and celebrate the BMW 507. Only 5703 were built: 3160 with Euro specs and 2543 with US specs. All were supplied with a color matching hard top. The Z8 gained fame as a James Bond 007 car in "The world is not enough".

This particular example is painted in the bleu metallic named Topazbleu. Only 319 were produced in this color and only 138 also had the cream full leather interior. It was a European delivered car that comes with a fully stamped service book. All services were done by official BMW dealerships. (Intervals: 1950 km - 18668 km - 42100 km - 68000 km) And the last service was done a few months ago in Belgium with 75.000 km on the odometer. The car comes with a full set of Belgian documents: registration, certificate of conformity, carpas and technical control. And with all original
