

AUSTIN HEALEY 100/6 BN6



Adorable two-tone "red-white" 1958 AUSTIN HEALEY 100/6 BN2 two seat roadster with the original black leather interior. Powered by the 6-in line OHV engine with 2639 cc, breathing through a set of twin SU H4 carburetors producing 117 bhp. Giving this car a top speed of 180 km/h. Attached to a 4 speed manual gearbox with the optional overdrive unit.

This particular car was built as a LHD car and supplied to the US. First owner from 1958 till 1969. Second owner was Mr Goodway, living at the historic "Pine Heaven Estate" in Holt, Missouri (US). He owned this BN6 from 1969 till 1992. The car was part of his Austin Healey collection almost owning every type of Healey built. He had 2 BN6 cars in his collection and sold this car in 1992 to the 3rd owner a famous Belgian collector. He drove and serviced the car with a lot of care and attention. After 23 years of ownership the car is for sale.

With chassis nr 579 this BN6 is an early production car (from 501 till 4650) with its matching engine type 26D with the "R" (overdrive) specification. Because it is an "De Luxe Model" it comes with the following options: two-tone paint, wire wheels (now converted to 15 inch alloy Minilites) a heater and the overdrive. Some modifications were made as: disc brakes at front and side pipe exhaust. Car comes with a folding hood (soft top), tonneau cover and a perfect set of detachable perspex side screens.

An unique opportunity to require a 100/6 BN6 with full ownership history. A real "drivers car" with some usable extra's. Ready for his next passionated owner.
