

PORSCHE 996 TARGA



Beautiful and low mileage "artic silver" 2002 Porsche 996 targa with black leather interior. The 996 featured the most significant change from the classic 911 series by using a water cooled engine. Emission and noise regulations, environmental concerns and higher expectations for refinement and higher performance 4 valve per cylinder engines made this switch necessary.

This 2002 car is equipped with the 3.6 water cooled boxer engine producing 320 hp and is attached to a 6 speed manual gearbox with rear wheel drive. This example was originally delivered to Italy with the special option code 762. Which means market launch or dealer car. When Porsche presented a new model the usually send a bunch of cars with the same specifications out to the dealers as demo cars. It was imported into Belgium during 2011. The car comes with a full set of documents: Belgian registration, carpass, certificate of conformity, all original books and a fully stamped service book.

The 996 is an amazing looking car. With the sliding glass in "green house" roof style gives the car lots of elegance. If you look to the car from the back the big and darker glass surface gives the car a real 4S look. So if you are looking for a low mileage example with a service book this is the one to have.
